School Library Card

Principals complete an application each school year for a list of authorized users, so they may borrow items to supplement their curriculum. The card is kept on file at the Library.

Class Visits and Tours

Call to schedule a Library visit, storytime, book talk, or a presentation to coordinate with class topics. You may also schedule librarians to visit your classroom.

Research

- **NoveList K-8 Plus**
Offers information and reading suggestions and Lexile readability for more than 200,000 titles.
- **World Book Encyclopedia Online**
Includes all of the articles available in the print version and more.
