Exterior

- Provide better access to patio (for children and better wayfinding for everyone)
- Provide more shade on patio
- Provide better access to large open programming area and learning garden
- Possible picnic area in front of building with better access

General

- Renovate Restrooms, provide bottle fillers
- Provide better signage/ wayfinding
- All services desks need to be updated and provide ample space
- Provide more storage

Lobby/Meeting Room:

- Provide better wayfinding upon entry including letting patrons know youth is upstairs & people can't find meeting room.
- Meeting room doesn't need kitchen, can be used for additional storage. Current storage is cluttered/exposed.
- Meeting room AV needs to be rethought for better function (Monitors, Screen + Sound)
- Freshen up lobby finishes and Friends (which can be relocated)
- Hub is not used as intended, could be used for programming and as collaborative space
- Add more LOT shelving/ storage
- Too much congestion at book drops, stair, circulation desk
- Study collections and spaces in circulation desk lobby

Adult Collection

- Cramped, cannot lose any shelving space
- Computers should be near reference desk
- AV doesn't need to be near entry
- Provide better seating and more comfortable options
- Keep a quiet room, possible fireplace
- There are enough study rooms, although one large room could be converted to 2 small
- Overall flow needs to be better

Teen:

- Space could be more flexible, note that teens are loud and should be in a loud zone & enclosed.

Youth Collection

- Story room needs to be larger
- Provide more comfortable furniture
- Provide tween space
- Keep craft area out in the open space
- Play area could be larger
- Could use a family restroom and nursing room on this floor

Staff Areas

- Circulation workroom is ample, there is wasted space behind current desk
- Update staff lounge and appliances
- Adult staff area is too small, consider changes in IT/Marketing area
