RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NON-RESIDENT CARDS FOR 2025-2026 FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the Bartlett Public Library District (the Library District) is a Public Library District operating pursuant to the Public Library District Act, 75 ILCS 16/1-1 *et seq.* (the Act); and

WHEREAS, residents and taxpayers of the Library District are eligible to receive library cards; and

WHEREAS, the Act provides that the Board of Library Trustees (the Board) of the Library District may allow non-residents to purchase a library card, i.e., the Act provides "The board may extend the privileges and use of the library, including the borrowing of materials on an individual basis by persons residing outside the district" (75 ILCS 16/30-55.60); and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Administrative Code provides three formulae which Public Libraries may use to determine the non-resident fee; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined to participate in the non-resident reciprocal borrowing program of its regional library system and to issue non-resident library cards.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD RESOLVES as follows:

Section 1: Individuals residing beyond the jurisdictional boundaries of the Library District and not residing within the boundaries of another Public Library jurisdiction and owning no taxable property within the jurisdictional boundaries of the Library District may purchase a non-resident fee card. The non-resident fee is determined by the Tax Bill Method (23 Ad. Code 3050.60{b}). Under this method, the non-resident card fee is calculated by applying the Library District's total tax rate to the non-resident property owner's principal residence assessed valuation. The most recent property tax bill will be used. The non-resident property owner will pay the same amount as would be paid if the property was in the Library District. However, costs paid by persons residing outside of the district may be paid biannually.

Section 2: Examples of using the Tax Bill Method:

<u>Market Value</u>	<u>Assessed Value (1/3 of market value)</u>	\times	<u>Library's Tax Rate</u>	$=$	<u>Fee</u>
\$210,000	\$70,000	x	0.002764	=	\$193.48
\$360,000	\$120,000	x	0.002764	=	\$331.69

Section 3: The Library Director will provide a copy of this Resolution to the regional library system within 30 days of the adoption of this Resolution.
