RANK	POTENTIAL INDIVIDUAL PROJECTS
	PROGRAMMING SPACES: Additional and larger spaces for programming activities, allowing for more programming to fulfill the community’s wishes as well as increased capacity to meet community demand. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$1.5 million)</i>
	STUDY ROOMS & QUIET SPACES: Additional rooms and spaces to allow library patrons to read, learn, work, and relax in a quiet, peaceful atmosphere. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$600,000)</i>
	BUILDING LAYOUT & ACCESSIBILITY: More efficient library layout including relocating service desk and staff closer to the front entrance as well as improved building accessibility including investments in entrances, restrooms, and the elevator. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$2.5 million)</i>
	TECHNOLOGY: Dedicated STEM and Career & Technical Education spaces with improved access to technology, including a makerspace, to allow for hands on learning and the opportunity to explore new ideas and potential careers. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$750,000)</i>
	DRIVE-UP WINDOW: New drive-up window allowing patrons to drop-off and renew items conveniently from the comfort of their vehicle, which is helpful to seniors and parents with young children. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$800,000)</i>
	YOUTH SPACES: Improved spaces specifically designed for children, including larger story time and crafting rooms and a larger play space with innovative toys to encourage kids to explore, play, and be creative in a safe environment. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$4.5 million)</i>
	BOOKS & SHELVING: Additional and improved shelving to allow the district to expand its collection of books and audiovisual materials that is currently maximized due to space constraints and lack of shelving. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$200,000)</i>
	MEETING SPACES: Additional and larger meeting spaces to meet the demand from community organizations looking for meeting space in our community. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$900,000)</i>
	OUTDOOR SPACES: Dedicated spaces on library grounds with permanent seating to allow for outdoor programming for all ages with potential for enclosing the courtyard to make it an indoor/outdoor educational and programming space. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$300,000 to \$1.2 million)</i>
	ADULT & TEEN SPACES: Additional quiet and collaborative spaces for adults and teens to meet the high demand for space. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$4.65 million)</i>
	SUSTAINABILITY: Investments in renewable energy such as solar roof panels as well as more environmentally friendly features such as energy-efficient boilers, HVAC equipment and a green roof. <i>(Estimated Cost: \$650,000)</i>

	NEW LIBRARY: New Library Building \$32.5 million Avg Tax Impact: \$239/yr*
